- Christine Hill-Wilson made a motion to approve the December 2023 meeting minutes with any specified changes and seconded by Kristen Slater. The motion passed and the Dec. 2023 minutes were approved w/out objection.
- Committee reports: Treasurer’s report as of Dec 31, 2023, provided by Christine Hill-Wilson.
